



Selbro Resource Centre

Occupational Therapy and Sensory Impairment Service

Selbro is a jointly funded initiative between the Orkney Islands Council (OIC) and the National Health Service in Orkney (NHSO).

Who is the service for?

The centre is for people who have difficulties managing their daily living activities and could benefit from the use of assistive equipment to help them manage more independently.

We are also happy to provide general information to families, friends, carers or other interested parties.

Selbro is available for anyone who is interested in equipment to assist with a disability regardless of current or previous contact with the Occupational Therapy, Sensory Impairment or Telecare Services.

What is at the Selbro Resource Centre?

It provides an opportunity for people to look at, discuss and try some of the equipment currently available.

The centre has a variety of displays that are based around equipment available for the:

- Kitchen.
- Living room.
- Bathroom / Toilet.
- Bedroom areas.

There is also a room where you can look at a range of equipment designed to help people with a sight or hearing loss to remain independent.

Various Telecare devices are installed for anyone who is interested in seeing a demonstration of electronic assistive equipment.

When can I come along?

Access to Selbro at this time is by appointment only – please phone 01856 873535 extension 2632. We will arrange for an Occupational therapist to contact you by phone to discuss your enquiry and book an appointment with you if required.

Staff can provide details of how you can purchase equipment yourself or if it could be available to you on loan. (A Community Care/Telecare Assessment is required before Telecare equipment can be installed.)

Staff can also advise if further assessment at home would be beneficial and may suggest that you contact the Community Care Duty Worker to make an OT, RO or Telecare referral, on 01856 873535, between 09:00 and 13:00 Monday to Friday.

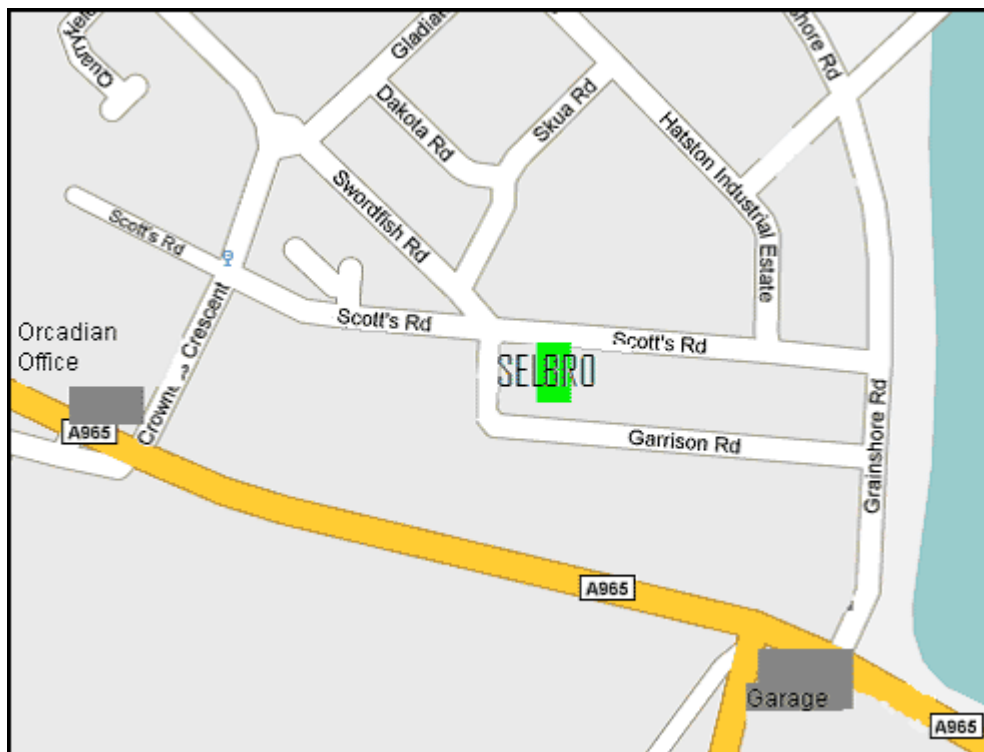
