

THE ORKNEY ISLANDS COUNCIL (50 MPH SPEED LIMIT)
(A965 HATSTON PARK AREA AND SUNNYBANK ROAD, ST OLA)
ORDER 2015

The Orkney Islands Council in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- One This Order may be cited as The Orkney Islands Council (50 mph Speed Limit) (A965 Hatston Park Area and Sunnybank Road, St Ola) Order 2015 and shall come into operation on the day of Two Thousand and Fifteen.
- Two The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- Three No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding fifty miles per hour in any of the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

1. That part of the public road A965, St Ola from a point Five metres or thereby northwest of the westernmost boundary of 1 Hatston Park, St Ola to a point One Hundred and Thirty Six metres or thereby northwest of the westernmost junction with the unclassified Grainbank Road, St.Ola, a total distance of Five Hundred and Fifty Three metres or thereby.
2. The unclassified Sunnybank Road, St Ola from its junction with the A965 to a point Fifteen metres or thereby north of its junction with the C1 Old Finstown Road, a total distance of One Thousand, Seven Hundred and Thirteen metres or thereby.
3. That part of the unclassified Blackhill Road, St.Ola from its junction with Sunnybank Road, St.Ola, in a northwesterly direction for a distance of Fifteen metres or thereby, a total distance of Fifteen metres or thereby.

All as shown coloured red on the plan annexed and executed as relative to this Order.
