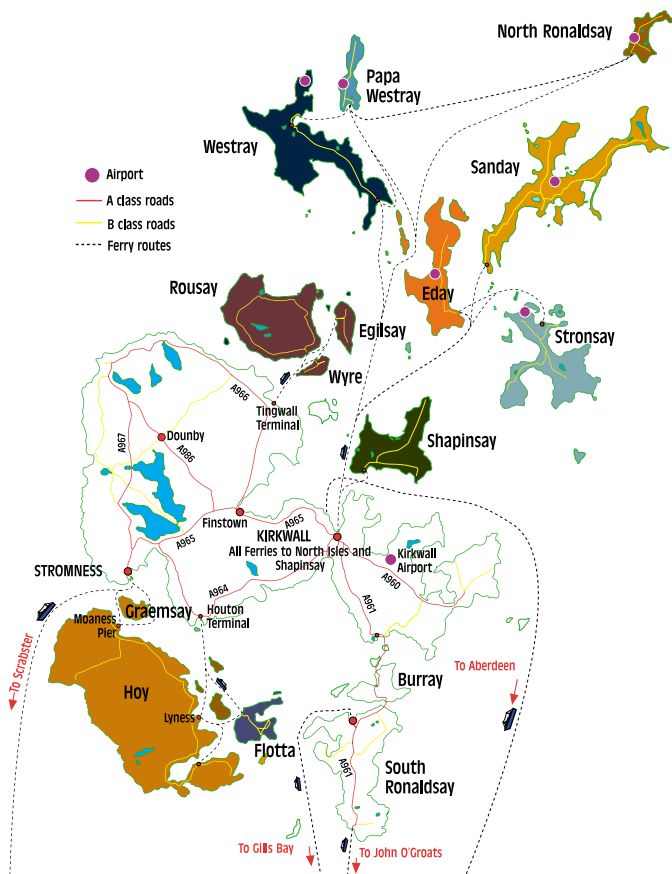

Orkney concessions and discounts for travellers

• Scotland-wide Free Bus Scheme for people who are older or disabled ...

Anyone aged sixty or over and eligible disabled people who live in Scotland are entitled to travel free on any local bus service and scheduled long-distance coach service throughout Scotland with the National Entitlement Card.

Permanent residents in Orkney are also entitled to two free return ferry journeys to the Scottish Mainland or Shetland per year. These four ferry vouchers are issued each year for use between April to March the following year.

• Orkney Islands Council Concessionary Travel Scheme for people who are older or disabled ...

Orkney residents who are aged 61 and over or are disabled, and in possession of the National Entitlement Card and reside permanently on one of the isles, are also entitled to 12 free return ferry trips. The qualifying age for this local concession will increase on an annual basis by one year, thereby raising the qualifying age from 61 to 65 over the next 5 years.

The concessionary travel vouchers are issued in March each year for use between April and March the following year. Eligible residents of North Ronaldsay and Papa Westray are eligible for twelve free return trips on the scheduled plane service.

• Orkney Islands Council Community Transport Concessionary Travel Scheme ...

Orkney residents who are disabled or over the age of 61, are also entitled to one free return trip per week on eligible Community Transport schemes, such as Dial-a-Bus. Residents must be in possession of a National Entitlement Card. The qualifying age for this local concession will increase on an annual basis by one year, thereby raising the qualifying age from 61 to 65 over the next 5 years.

• Scotland-wide Young Persons' Concessionary Travel Scheme ...

All 16-18 year olds and young full-time volunteers up to the age of 25 are entitled to concessionary travel on buses and rail using their National Entitlement Card. The scheme provides one third off bus and rail travel. Eligible people in Orkney are also entitled to two free return journeys to the Scottish Mainland or Shetland each year, including any connecting journey on an Orkney Ferries service.

• Air Discount Scheme (ADS) Reservations 0844 800 2855

The ADS scheme provides 40% off flights to the Scottish Mainland and other eligible areas in the Highlands and Islands. The ADS scheme is available to anyone whose main residence is Orkney. The scheme also includes students from

Orkney who are studying away from home. Information on applying for the air discount scheme is available at www.airdiscountscheme.com or by calling 0800 032 2890.

• NorthLink Islander Scheme

Permanent residents of Orkney qualify for the NorthLink Ferries Islander Discount. The scheme provides a 30% discount on standard fares for passengers and non-commercial passenger accompanied vehicles. Information on the scheme is available from NorthLink Ferries on 01856 885500 and at www.northlinkferries.co.uk.

• Highland Rail Card

Residents of Orkney are entitled to purchase a Highland Rail Card which gives 50% off rail travel on the following routes:

- Mallaig/ Fort William/ Oban – Glasgow
- Wick/Thurso – Inverness
- Kyle of Lochalsh – Inverness
- Valid on ScotRail services only

Highland Rail Cards are available from the following staffed stations: Inverness, Dingwall, Kyle of Lochalsh, Wick, Thurso, Oban, Fort William or Mallaig. Alternatively, application forms are available from www.scotrail.co.uk or from Orkney Islands Council Customer Services and from the Kirkwall Travel Centre. The current cost for the rail card is £8 (valid for 12 months).

• Using the bus – Hail and Ride

All you need to do to catch a bus is to wait at a safe point – and hail the driver as the bus approaches. When you wish to leave the bus, ring the bell once in good time as the bus approaches your stop. Bus fares vary depending upon the length of your journey. If you are making a return journey on the same day, ask the driver for a Day Return. Other multiple-use tickets are available, and details can be found at www.stagecoachbus.com



Members of the public should note that in areas of Kirkwall and Stromness for reasons of safety, you should wait for the bus at the Kirkwall or Stromness Travel Centre or appropriate bus shelter/stop where the bus is designated to stop.

• Using Loganair inter-isles services

Loganair services to the Outer North Isles depart from Kirkwall Airport. Bookings should be made in advance by calling Loganair on 01856 872494 / 01856 873457.



Passengers are required to check-in at least 20 minutes before departure. Each passenger is allowed 15kgs hold luggage. A connecting bus service from Kirkwall is available to meet these internal flights.

• Using Dial-a-Bus service

01856 871515

Dial-A-Bus is a door-to-door service run for its members by the Orkney Disability Forum. Residents and visitors can become members, and the service is available for people who are disabled, people with mobility difficulties and people aged 60 and over.

The Dial-A-Bus office is open Monday to Friday 09:00 to 4:30pm for further information and booking. Bookings for Dial-A-Bus must be made 24 hours in advance and trips at the weekend must be booked by Friday. Dial-A-Bus has an out-of-hours phone line that can be used if you need to cancel your booking or change your pick-up or drop-off point. The number is 0750 030 4417 – please note that journeys cannot be booked on this line.

• Using Orkney Ferries Services

Orkney Ferries services to the Outer North Isles (Eday, North Ronaldsay, Papa Westray, Sanday, Stronsay & Westray) depart from the Kirkwall Pier.

Orkney Ferries services to Shapinsay depart from the Shapinsay slip adjacent to the Kirkwall Pier. All vehicle bookings should be made in advance on 01856 872044.

Orkney Ferries service to Rousay, Egilsay and Wyre depart from the Tingwall Pier. All vehicle bookings should be made in advance on 01856 751360.

Orkney Ferries service to Hoy and Flotta depart from the Houton Pier. All vehicle bookings should be made in advance on 01856 811397. Vehicle traffic should arrive at the pier no later than 20 minutes before the scheduled sailing time, and foot passengers by 10 mins before the sailing time.

Orkney Ferries passenger service to Graemsay and Moaness (North of Hoy) departs from the Graemsay Pier in Stromness. All enquiries should be made through Stevie Mowat on 01865 850624. Passengers for this service are required to be available for boarding five minutes before departure.

Kick Start Kirkwall



The Kick Start Kirkwall campaign created by Orkney Islands Council is one of the seven Sustainable Travel Demonstration Towns funded by Smarter Choices, Smarter Places.

The aim of the project is to encourage both residents and visitors to Kirkwall to reduce their car use in favour of more sustainable modes of travel. The project has been running for 3 years and is due to end in 2011. Orkney Islands Council Transportation Service will however continue to promote sustainable travel throughout Orkney.

Kick Start Kirkwall projects include:-

- Path to Health at the Peedie Sea – creating a new path network with rest areas to encourage people to incorporate exercise as part of their everyday routine;
- Town Infrastructure – creating new path sections, upgrading existing paths and joining up path networks to bridge gaps and overcome constraints;
- Promoting Smarter Travel Choices in Kirkwall – a promotional strategy including personalised travel planning (PTP) in Kirkwall and Shapinsay and travel maps to encourage people to walk and cycle more;
- Wayfinding – signage in Kirkwall which indicates walking and cycling networks as well as key points of interest. Ideal for tourists, the signage will be located at the Kirkwall Travel Centre and Harbour area.

Transport and Carbon reduction initiatives

Scotland has set itself far reaching targets for carbon reduction with 'almost complete decarbonisation of road transport by 2050 with significant progress by 2030.'

The key message is that the following will be significant:

- The adoption of electric cars and vans;
- Improved vehicle technologies, namely, the shift to hybrid and electric vehicles;
- An electric charging infrastructure to support the use of plug-in hybrid and electric vehicles across Scotland;
- The need for additional planning and demand management measures through to 2020 to reduce the need for travel and the carbon intensity of travel; and to maximise active travel (e.g. walking and cycling).

Although many policy initiatives sit at an EU and UK level, Scotland has powers over measures such as:

- Infrastructure;
- Smarter Measures such as measures concerning more fuel efficient "eco-"driving;
- Demand management measures;
- Integrated public transport and maximising active travel (cycling and walking).

Orkney Islands Council recognises the development for a low-carbon, multi-modal and integrated transport system, 'now, tomorrow and for future generations' and the vision remains to achieve 'a sustainable future for transport.'

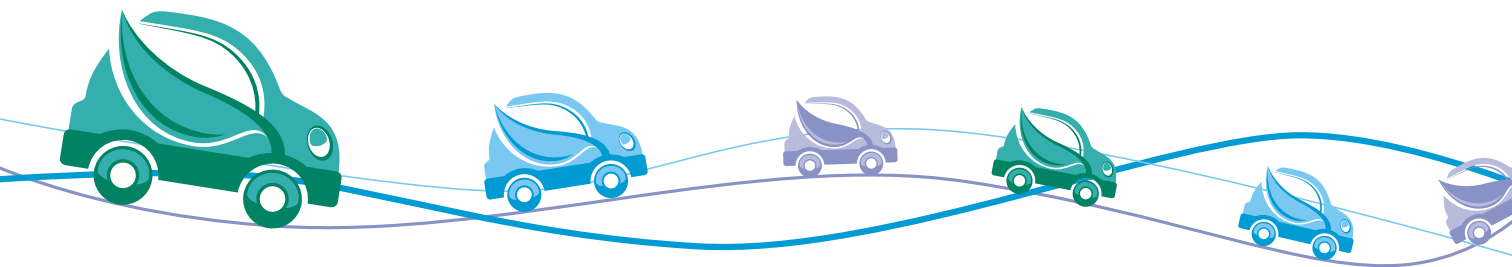
In April 2011, the Orkney Community Planning Partnership announced through a press release, a proposal to trial electric vehicles with the replacement of two Orkney Islands Council fleet vehicles and the installation of associated charging points.

OCCP Chair Stephen Hagan said, "Encouraging use of electricity to power vehicles also fits in with Orkneys potential as a renewables centre – electric vehicles could be one way for the county to capitalise on over-production from wind and marine turbines and strengthen our case for improved grid connectivity, which in turn helps attract renewables developers to the county."

The Council has offered interested community groups the opportunity to view the vehicles and to be taken on a test drive. The electric Peugeot 'iON' car was also made available to the public on Dounby and County Show day.

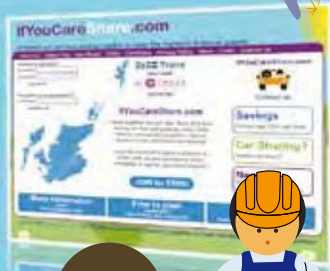

Winter Car Check



Before you start to drive you should ensure that your vehicle is roadworthy.

Carry out the following checks.

- Visual examination of the exterior for damage or defects.
- Tools and jack are present and in good order.
- Wheels in good order and nuts secure (do not over-tighten, especially with alloy wheels).
- Tyres – check all the tyres, including the spare, for;
 - Damage.
 - Tread depth.
 - Pressure (pressure settings are only accurate when tyres are cold).
 - Compatibility of type.
- Adequate fuel, oil, water, windscreen wash and other fluids.
- Fan belt in good condition and correctly tensioned.
- Lights in working order including,
 - high intensity foglights.
 - indicators.
 - Reversing lights.
 - Brake lights.
- Windscreen wipers and washers in good condition.
- Horn working correctly.
- Have warm clothing / blankets to hand.
- All glass clean – windows inside and out, lenses, mirrors.



A useful aid to remember the key points to check is:

P O W E R
petrol oil water electrics rubbers (tyres & wipers)
