Eligibility Criteria Check

To be eligible to apply for this fund, your project must deliver on <u>one</u> of the following outcomes:

| Creating sustainable public services - grants from £2,000 up to £7,000 for projects |

| which support sustainable public services, such as enabling mainland based third sector groups to provide outreach services and to deliver their services or activities to rural areas and the isles. Applications may also be considered from isles based groups wishing to participate in existing collaborative projects on a trial basis. Grants can cover up 100% of eligible revenue costs. Capital costs can be covered up to a maximum of £5,000. |
| Transforming the economy to deliver net zero - grants from £2,000 up to £7,000 for |
| projects designed to support net zero, such as increased recycling, upcycling, waste eduction and community growing projects. Feasibility studies and pre-project activity may also be eligible. Grants can cover up 100% of eligible revenue costs. Capital costs can be covered up to a maximum of £5,000. |
