

# **Minute of the Special Meeting of Stronsay Community Council held in Stronsay Community Centre on Monday, 5 February 2018 at 19:30**

## **1. Apologies**

Resolved to note that apologies for absence had been received from Mr J Seaton.

## **2. Stronsay Fish Mart**

Due to the sensitive nature of this item, it was taken in private.

Members heard a report regarding the Operators agreement for the Stronsay Fish Mart, and it was resolved:

1. To note the information.
2. That the Chair would meet with the Operators.
3. That a request for various works to be done to Stronsay Fish Mart would be submitted to Orkney Islands Council.
4. That a further Special Meeting would be convened to discuss further measures required, if necessary.

## **3. Haulage of Aggregates**

Members heard that twelve applications had been received in response to notices that had been displayed offering residents assistance with the haulage costs of aggregates from Mainland Orkney to Stronsay, to be used for the improvement of private roadways leading to occupied dwellings. Community Council Grant Scheme funding had been awarded for this project, and consideration was given to a written report, circulated to members at the meeting, giving details of the applications received, and it was resolved:

1. To note the information.
2. That each applicant would receive a grant towards the haulage cost of aggregates to be used for the improvement of a private roadway leading to an occupied dwelling, the amount depending on the quantity of aggregates being ordered.
3. That, to claim the grant, each applicant should order their own aggregates, arrange haulage and cover all associated costs, and forward a copy of the haulage invoice to the Island Link Officer before 16 March 2018.
4. That the Island Link Officer would write and inform the twelve applicants of the grant awarded and the conditions to be met before the grant would be issued.

## **4. Conclusion**
