



Local Housing Allowance - Rates for Orkney

Leaflet HB(LHA)5.

The Local Housing Allowance rates are the maximum amount of Housing Benefit that will be paid for tenants renting accommodation from a private landlord.

If you live in Council accommodation or rent from the Orkney Housing Association, Local Housing Allowance will not affect you.

The table below shows the Local Housing Allowance rates for Orkney from 1 April 2020.

Number of bedrooms.	Category.	Weekly amount.
Shared room rate.	A.	£61.84.
1 bedroom.	B.	£93.37.
2 bedrooms.	C.	£112.60.
3 bedrooms.	D.	£129.08.
4 bedrooms or more.	E.	£163.11.

The rate that applies to you will depend on the size of your household and how many bedrooms that you and your family are assessed as needing. To find out how to work out which Local Housing Allowance rate applies to you, see our leaflet, HB(LHA)2 Working out your Local Housing Allowance.
