Child's Plan

- ✓ Single or multiagency
- ✓ Child at the Centre



Chronology

- ✓ Annexed to the Child's Plan



Plan development

- ✓ After review a new plan is created
- ✓ Only includes details and background since previous plan
- ✓ Keeps the plan focused on what is relevant and does not keep highlighting the past to the Child or Young Person
- ✓ A new version would be used to close or step down the plan giving the narrative to this recommendation



Agency specialist documents feed into Child's Plan

- Assessments => 'Outcomes of specialist assessments' section
- Specialist plans / supporting documents => 'Action plan' section
- These can be annexed to the Child's Plan if required



Things to note

- Accessible by the child or Parent
- Puts the child at the centre
- Partnership => common language, common approach
- Designed around the SHANARI wellbeing indicators
- Enables specialist assessment or supporting plans to feed into it
- Scalable to supports a 'stepped up, stepped down' approach
